

## AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING

## AR.1A - Trophy and Class B races

### **Summary:**

Racing Australia has determined to increase prizemoney thresholds for Trophy and Class B races as follows:

- Trophy race increased from \$3,500 to \$5,000; and
- Class B race increased from \$10,000 to \$12,500.

#### 1. Amend AR.1A as follows:

# "AR.1A

. . .

A **Trophy Race** is a race in which the prizemoney and/or value of any trophy to the winner does not exceed \$5,000.

. . .

A **Class B Race**\* is one restricted to horses which, at the time of starting, have not generated prizes in the aggregate worth more than \$12,500 for wins in races on the flat and have never won a race on the flat outside Australia.

\* The value of the prize to the winner shall not exceed: in a Class A Race - \$6,000 in a Class B Race - \$12,500.
