
FOL Trial Survey Summary

In March 2018, Racing Queensland conducted a survey, which invited industry participants across Queensland to state their views on the nine-month Finish On Lure (FOL) trial conducted at Albion Park in 2017.

Participants were invited to make their submissions online, or via a hard copy survey distributed to all seven Queensland clubs. In total, 131 participants responded to the survey.

A summary of the data collected is published below.


Age bracket

- F) 70+ 20%




Please select the region which best describes the location of your training operation

- C) North Queensland 5%


Did you participate in Finish On Lure races during the trial period?

- B) No 25%




Did you find it useful to have the Finish On Lure meetings for greyhounds that offended (Failing to pursue/marring) in the past?

- C) Undecided 9%


What Impact did the Finish On Lure trial have on your nomination pattern?
