## Field Composition:

Four representatives each from QLD and NSW. No reserves.

## Field Selection:

Each state team will be selected by a panel of experts. For QLD the Panel should be chaired by a representative from Racing Queensland. For NSW the Panel should be chaired by a representative from GRNSW.

Representatives for each state will be announced on Monday, June 5, 2023.

## Preferential Box Draw:

Trainers will nominate for a Rail (R) or Wide (W) box.

A Racing Queensland panel will approve box draw nominations prior to the box draw.

A Preferential Box Draw will be conducted manually by QRIC Stewards on Wednesday, June 14, 2023.

## Conditions:

To be eligible to be drawn, a greyhound must have raced or trialed at Capalaba prior to the box draw.

## Queensland Eligibility:

- A greyhound is eligible to be nominated for Queensland if it has been domiciled in Queensland for at least 76 of the 150 days immediately preceding June 18, 2023.
- If the greyhound has not been trained for a total of 76 days in its career, it will be deemed to be eligible for Queensland if it has been trained in Queensland for all its race starts.
- A greyhound shall be deemed to be domiciled in Queensland commencing on the date on which the change of kennel notification form (or equivalent evidence produced) is received by QRIC.

## New South Wales Eligibility

- A greyhound is eligible to be nominated for New South Wales if it has been domiciled in New South Wales for at least 76 of the 150 days immediately preceding June 18, 2023.
- If the greyhound has not been trained for a total of 76 days in its career, it will be deemed to be eligible for New South Wales if it has been trained in New South Wales for all its race starts.
- A greyhound shall be deemed to be domiciled in New South Wales commencing on the date on which the change of kennel notification form (or equivalent evidence produced) is received by GWIC.
