## RACING QUEENSLAND DRESS CODE GREYHOUND TAB RACING CLUBS

### TRAINERS / HANDLERS

#### CLOTHING:

- White collared business or polo shirt.
- Black jacket / jumper or vest.
- Black trouser / business pants with black belt (Optional) or black skirt (minimum knee length).
- Black dress shorts are permitted at race meetings where the first race is scheduled before 2pm.
- Greyhound club or racing logos are permitted. Dark (navy blue or black) panels / stripes on side of polo shirts are permitted.
- No t-shirts, singlets, running/athletics shorts, board shorts, jeans or tracksuit pants.

#### FOOTWEAR:

- Black enclosed shoes – waterproof with rubber soles with plain black or plain white socks.
- No high heels, thongs, joggers or sandals.

#### HEADWEAR:

- Black or White hat / caps (Optional).
- Akubra style hats permitted.
- Hats must have a brim and worn with the peak to the front (i.e. Baseball caps).
- No beanies.

#### FEAURE RACE DAYS:

- Queensland Greyhound Racing Clubs may ask Greyhound Racing License holders to wear special feature race day attire from time to time. I.e. Black suit vests, bow tie etc.

#### SPECIAL PURPOSES:

- Racing Queensland may approve race day attire for special purposes which falls outside the standards outlined in the dress code above.

### CATCHERS

- Catchers must present themselves in a neat and professional manner.
- Dress shorts are permitted at race meetings where the first race is scheduled before 2pm.
- The following are not permitted: Running/athletic shorts, board shorts, tracksuit pants, singlets, high heels, thongs or sandals.
