

## 1. Purpose

The [Racing Act 2002 \(Qld\)](#) requires Racing Queensland (RQ) to make a policy for the way in which races are to be held. The purpose of this policy is to ensure Queensland races are conducted in accordance with the Rules of Racing and RQ policies.

## 2. Scope

This policy applies to all race meetings conducted in Queensland and relates to the conditions under which races are held. This policy affects all race clubs licensed to conduct race meetings.

## 3. Policy Statement

- The allocation of race days is governed by RQ's [Allocation of Race Days Policy](#).
- Race clubs must only conduct race meetings and betting meetings on days allocated by RQ, as published in the Racing Calendar for each code (Thoroughbred, Greyhound, & Harness).
- The classes of races that Queensland race clubs run will be in accordance with the conditions described in the Rules of Racing and any conditions advised by RQ.

## 4. Roles & Responsibilities

**RQ** will allot race days and approve conditions for races.

**Race clubs** must comply with the RQ Policies and Rules of Racing that govern the way races are to be held.
