FINAL CONDITIONS:

- To be eligible to compete in the Final, horses must have competed in a minimum of one (1) Heat.
- It is a requirement to nominate for the Final i.e. horses will not be automatically nominated.

FINAL BALLOTING CONDITIONS:

- Composition of the field will be determined at acceptance time by the highest two (2) placegetters (1st, 2nd, 3rd) in each of the six (6) Heats. (see condition below regarding dead-heats)
- If a horse places first or second in more than one (1) Heat, it will be it will be deemed to have qualified in the first of those Heats.
- If there are not two (2) placegetters from each Heat declared as acceptors for the Final, third placegetter from other Heats that have not already secured a place in the Final will be eligible to be included. Preference will be determined on the following basis:
 - 1. The horse with the highest official RQ rating
 - 2. If two or more horses have the same official RQ rating, they will be balloted by lot.
- If all placegetters from the Heats are exhausted and the Final field (plus emergencies) is still not complete, then unplaced horses from the Heats that have nominated for the Final, will complete the composition of the field for the Final. Preference will be determined on the following basis:
 - 1. The horse with the highest official RQ rating
 - 2. If two or more horses have the same official RQ rating, they will be balloted by lot.
- Should there be any dead-heats in the Heats, preference will be determined on the following basis:
 - 1. The horse with the highest official RQ rating at the time of final acceptance of Heat.
 - 2. If two or more horses have the same official RQ rating, they will be balloted by lot.

QUALIFYING HEAT CONDITIONS:

- To be eligible to compete in a Heat, a horse must have started in a minimum of three (3) non-Tab races in Queensland in the 12 months immediately preceding the acceptance date for that Heat specifically.
- · Qualifiers will not be divided.
