Certificate II in Racing Industry



This qualification describes the skills and knowledge for supporting job roles in the horse or greyhound racing industry. It allows for specialisation in various roles, including stable hand (harness or thoroughbred), stud hand (breeding), track maintenance and racing administration.

Individuals with this qualification carry out routine tasks under supervision where the work is predictable and structured with limited judgement requirements.

Work must comply with work health and safety and environmental regulations and legislation that apply to the workplace.

Licensing or registration requirements apply to this qualification in some states and territories. You are advised to check with the relevant Principal Racing Authority for current requirements.

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

Fourteen (14) units of competency

- Four (4) core units plus
- Ten (10) elective units.

This qualification has specialisations and depending on your choice of electives you could be issued a certificate in the following:

- Certificate II in Racing Industry (Stablehand)
- Certificate II in Racing Industry (Stud Hand)
- Certificate II in Racing Industry (Track Maintenance)
- Certificate II in Racing Industry (Administration)

You will be guided in your unit selection through consultation with your course advisor - **this is a Nationally recognised qualification**
